The Centre for Technology Based Assessment (TBA) at DIPF is an internationally renowned interdisciplinary research and development unit in the field of technology-based assessment. For instance, the TBA Centre is responsible for the entire technical realisation of the BKE (Berufliche Kompetenzen erkennen) project "Identifying professional competencies". BKE aims at an improved assessment of professional competencies refugees and people with non-formal qualification levels have acquired in non-formal settings, thereby supporting them in finding employment or training opportunities.

Your tasks:

- autonomous planning and implementation of project-specific requirements
- realisation of administrative IT tasks (installation and configuration of servers, monitoring, service, documentation, technical support, cluster management)
- testing and approval of server software
- · load testing, monitoring, reporting

Requirements:

- Business Informatics/Computer Science degree (Bachelor) or similar qualification, entrants welcome - candidates with non-university training in the field and several years of work experience are likewise invited to apply.
- sound knowledge and certification of experience in working with the administration of Linux servers in highly available environments
- knowledge in virtualisation solutions servers
- knowledge in the area of monitoring and load tests of server software
- sound knowledge of common webhosting software (Apache, PHP, mySQL)
- preferably experience with replication of mySQL databases
- very good German and English language skills, written and spoken
- ability to schedule working hours corresponding to maintenance times
